Subject: Request for thorough measures to prevent infection (notice)

Since the lifting of the voluntary restraint on movement in Tokyo and other parts of the country, the number of infected people has been increasing, and in Miyagi Prefecture, a number of cases have been reported since mid-June, including multiple infections at the same restaurants. It's a situation of one layer of caution.

On campus, some face-to-face classes have resumed and students have begun to move into University House. However, there have been reports of cases of people commuting to the labs who were unwell, while others were returning to campus.

Therefore, please reemphasize the measures to prevent infection, including the management of physical condition. In addition, each student, faculty, and staff member is asked to strictly avoid activities that increase the risk of infection, and continue to prevent the spread of infection by self-awareness and responsible behavior.
