Notice: Regarding the Holding of Seminars and Other Events at FRIS < Emergency Action Plan Level 2>

When Tohoku University Emergency Action Plan is raised to Level 2, the event will be held online in principle. However, if the risk of infection is sufficiently low and the Director decides that the nature of the event requires a face-to-face meeting, the event may be held onsite or in a hybrid format at a seminar room of FRIS as follows, based on the Guidelines Regarding the Prevention of Coronavirus Infections at Events.

- 1. Emergency Action Plan Level 2 or lower is a requirement.
- 2. Those who wish to hold an event must consult with the Director and obtain permission in advance.
- 3. As a general rule, participants in the seminar room should be limited to members of Tohoku University for the time being, and the number of participants should be limited to around 15, including the organizers and related persons.
- 4. Speakers may be invited from outside the university if the institution to which they belong allows them to come to Sendai.
- 5. Meetings with foods and drinks are prohibited, including before and after the event.
- 6. The Director may order the cancellation of the face-to-face meeting depending on the situation.
